

Tips for Casting Zoom to your TV

Download the Zoom App to your Phone or Device

Set up screencasting: This can be done easily if you have a iPhone/AppleTV or Android/Chromecast combination, or a Roku. There are workarounds for other combinations, but they usually involve either passing the connection through a computer or some detectable screen lag.
